Town of Abrams, Oconto County – Right-of-Way Excavation Permit

PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes this permit is granted to allow performance of the specific work described herein. The following standard provisions and any included special provisions shall govern.

1. Before any permit may be issued for excavation within any town right-of-way, public street, or alley, the permittee shall execute and submit to the Town of Abrams a completed permit application.
2. Prior to commencement of work the permittee may be required to deposit with the Town Clerk a corporate surety in the sum necessary for the type and scope of construction, conditioned that such permittee will perform faithfully all work with due care and skill and in accordance with the laws, rules and regulations applicable hereto.
3. The permittee, as a condition of all issued permits, will indemnify and hold harmless the Town, its employees and its agents and the Owner of the premises against all damages, costs, expenses, outlays and claims arising out of negligence of the permittee in connection with such work.
4. All disturbed areas shall be returned to their present condition or better, subject to the satisfaction of the Town Board or its designee. Access to all public street intersections shall be maintained and all disturbed areas completely restored.
5. A copy of this permit, along with any plans and special provisions, shall be available upon request.
6. Upon completion of the work the permittee shall file a written notice of completion with the Town Clerk.
