ORDINANCE #5 December 16, 1999

SNOW REMOVAL PARKING LIMITATION

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Abrams Oconto County

SECTION I--TITLE AND PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Abrams Snow Removal Parking Limitation Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate parking on town roads for proper snow removal.

SECTION II--PARKING ON TOWN ROAD LIMITATIONS

The Town of Abrams, by use of its own snow removal equipment, recognizes that motorized vehicles parked on roads, streets and alleys during the winter months becomes a safety issue and hazard for emergency snow removal.

Winter months are considered November 1st to April 1st of any given year.

The Town Board hereby ordains that there will be no long-term parking of motorized vehicles on town roads, streets or alleys and hereby forbids the parking of any motorized vehicles between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. on any road, street or alley within the Township of Abrams from November 1st through April 1st in any given year.

SECTION III--APPLICABLE FINES

Any motorized vehicle found parked on any town road, street or alley in conflict with this ordinance will be towed at the owner's expense.

SECTION III--EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
